Code of conduct for Salisbury Fencing Club

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All Club members and volunteers must:

- respect the rights, dignity and worth of all athletes, officials and volunteers at all times.
- treat everyone equally regardless of age, sex, ethnic origin, religion, political persuasion, sexual orientation or physical disability.
- consider the well being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect.
- make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part
- promote the positive aspects of Fencing (e.g. fair play)
- display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance
- follow all guidelines laid down by the British Fencing and the Club
- Encouraged to be members of British Fencing.
- never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward
- never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances
- encourage performers to value their performances and not just results
